



### **DATABASE SEARCHING (Theological Articles):**

Over 900 articles on "catholic AND contraception" in the ATLA Religion Database available through the San Diego Public Library:



STEP 4: On the ATLA search interface, enter your search terms. Select "Full Text" and Publication type, and any other criteria that is important to your search. Click "Search".



STEP 5: Review result titles. Sort by date, relevance, author, or source. Narrow results by subject, publication, or publication date. Revise your search terms to conduct a new search if necessary. Click on the article link to view the article, download the PDF Full Text, or email the article to your email address.
